



More Than Sports Bylaws

Welcome to More Than Sports (**MTS**). Hoop Service basketball teams will be playing under the umbrella of **MTS**. We are very happy that you chose us to be your sports outlet. As Head Coach of Hoop Service, I Coach Thompson, will provide the opportunity for your child not only to learn and develop athletic skills but also life skills as well through my own personal experiences. We have developed the following policies and procedures to ensure high equitable standards for **MTS's** operation. It is imperative that you read, understand and agree to these rules and conditions as a member of Hoop Service basketball team. Should you have any questions concerning these policies or our operations, please contact the Director.

Article I - Membership

Section 1. **Coaches fee** - there will be a \$50/\$100 per month coaches fee due from each player at the first of each month during their individual season. For those who choose to make a payment plan, fees must be paid on time or you pose the risk of being suspended until fees are paid. Grades 3-6 pay \$50 and grades 7-12 pay \$100.

Section 2. **Player's fees** - each team will divide the number of practices, tournaments, uniforms cost, and anything else that the team may incur, between the number of players per team to come up with the player's fees. All fees must be paid in advance except for the coaches fee's if agreed upon in advance. Our golf tournaments and our annual auctions help Hoop Service to assist that families financially that cannot afford to pay all or part of their team fees. Families needing financial aide must be either on the free or reduced lunch program in their perspective school districts. Also, I fully expect the families getting assistance be on hand to help in our fundrasing efforts.

Section 3. **Voluntary Resignation** - if a player choose to quit the program after agreeing to take part, then all fees paid are forfeited. If an agreement was made to allow the family to make payments, then said family is still responsible for the remainder of the fees. It is not fair to go back an ask the other families to increase their fees since someone decided to quit.

Section 4. **Involuntary Suspension** - if a player is dismissed from the program for disciplinary reasons and/or parent problems, it will be up to the Director and the Board to refund fees.

Article II - Waiver of Liability

We understand the risk of injury and do not hold Calvin Thompson, MTS, Hoop Service or any of the facilities used for this program, responsible for any injuries that occurred while participating. We further understand that it is our sole responsibility to provide medical insurance for our kid which would apply in event of any such injury.

By paying your fees, you are agreeing to the terms of these bylaws.
